Financial Assistance for Purchase of Books/ Study Materials to needy and meritorious Students

The college has taken major efforts to facilitate the enrolled learners in every possible ways. Majority of the students in the college belong to minority sections and are first generation learners whose family incomes are mostly within Rs. 5000/- per month (estimated on the basis of income certificates submitted by candidates during admission time duly signed by councilors). So the college has felt the need to empower these meritorious but needy students in the best possible way by granting them book grant facilities keeping in mind the Central Government Scheme "Beti Bachao Beti Parhao".

This initiative of the college from the very inception is one of the best practices organized by Students Welfare subcommittee every year. In every academic session, when new students enroll for Semester 1, they are made aware about this unique facility of the college on the Orientation Day by the Students Welfare Subcommittee members.

Under this Book Grant facility offered by the collge, the needy and meritorious students are provided with one -time financial assistance to buy books and or contingency materials depending on their family means and merits. Students notice for the same with detailed instructions for applying under the same are circulated by the Students Welfare Subcommittee in the college notice board and in the website. The newly admitted students of Semester 1 (those interested) apply in plain paper addressing the Principal of the college statingthe reason behind the requirement of this book grant. Then an interview is arranged for the applicants from Semester -1 Batch. The selection is conducted by the interview in presence of Students welfare sub-committee members , the Principal and the IQAC coordinator. Final selection of students is done on the basis of the interview. The grant is paid from the Students Welfare Fund of the college. The grant amounts to the applicants vary based on family means, their genuine needs and the final score in the last passed examination at 10+2 level.

During the pre Pandemic sessions 2018-2019 and 2019-2020, the students selected under the Book grant were asked to provide the books list they needed based on grant amount in consultation with the department teachers and the subcommittee members took the responsibility of purchasing the books and handover the same to the respective students. But in the post pandemic sessions from 2021-2022, the students purchase the books by their own and submit the bills to the subcommittee members. Then after the physical verification of books with the bills the grant amount is transferred to the respective candidates bank account through online mode.

STEPS TO BE FOLLOWED FOR RECEIVING THE BOOK GRANT:

STEP I

- •Application in plain paper adressing the Principal based on the notice circulated in the college notice board
- •Reasons to be stated clearlyin the aplicaion paper by the students why the grant is needed

STEP II

- •Appearing in the interview on the scheduled date with original marshseet and family income certificate duly sgned by the local Councillor
- After final selection of the candidates based on merit and family means the books and or study materails to be purchased based on the grant amount aproved

STEP III

•The bills of books / study materials purcahsed to be submitted to the Student's Welfare Subcommitee members for physical verification of items purchased and for receiving the grant in their respective bank accounts
