The specific guidelines to be followed for taking part in the cooking competition are:

- 1. Students have to take part individually. No group participation is allowed.

- The item to be prepared should be an authentic desert item/sweet dish (which will reflect the family traditions)
- 4. Fireless cooking is only allowed. Under no circumstances the fire will be allowed in the room.
- The students may bring half cooked dishes from home if they need oven but final presentation and garnishing to be done at the college.

The judgement will start sharp from 3 p.m.
