



EDUCATIONAL FIELD TRIPS CONDUCTED BY THE DEPT. OF GEOGRAPHY SINCE 2018 TO 2023

Objective of the Educational field trip conducted by the Dept. of Geography

The major objective of conducting an Educational Excursion and field trip for students is to reinforce experiential and contextual learning.

Field trips enhance classroom learning by making real world connections. Teaching -learning process gets completed when experiences with fun are gained from educational tours and excursions. These trips are customized to facilitate the students to know and understand the real, multicultural world.

A host of activities are undertaken as a part of trips which act as a facilitator to think out of the box and broaden the outlook.

The Department of Geography as part of the course curriculum prescribed by the University of Calcutta under Geography Hons. UG program discreetly organizes educational trips to different urban and rural setups in order to make the students understand the man – environment relations/ interactions at different environments .

So far the Department has arranged field trips in

- Chakdah Municipality of Nadia District (2018)
- Dhamakhali Village of Sandeshkhaki II Block in North 24 Parganas District (2019)
- Lakhmipur Abad Village (Bakkhali) – in coastal area of Namkhana Block in South 24 Parganas district of West Bengal (2020)
- Taki – a river side town in Hasnabad Block of North 24 Parganas (2022)
- Bolpur – Shatiniketan in Birbhum District of West Bengal for the final year students of the Department (2023)

These educational trips give students the opportunity to observe a particular environment that enables first-hand experience of what they are learning. In addition, students achieve a higher level of critical thinking when they evaluate their own learning compared with what they get exposed to, and they are able to modify their knowledge based on their personal experiences. Field trips also offer students and teachers the opportunity to interact outside of the classroom, thus enhancing their bonding with each other and improving their social and life skills.

Expected Outcomes

The students as per their course curriculum (in Part III Geography Hons. – Annual System and GEOA Semester V – CC11_P –CBCS under the University of Calcutta) have to perform a host of activities in pre-field period , during the field study (whether an urban area or in a rural setup) and in the post field phase. In the pre-field part, the students learn how to select a specific area based on a definite problem , the methodology to be followed for the entire study and to sort out different sources of primary and secondary data to be collected to perform the field study.

Each and every field trip starts with the reconnaissance survey of the entire area of study on Day 1 and with subsequent time the students perform detailed instrument survey for measuring relief and slope with the survey instruments like dumpy level, prismatic compass, clinometer etc. The students also perform the entire landuse mapping of the area along with soil sample collections from different land-use plots. Further to study the socio-economic conditions of the inhabitants which is an essential part, they perform different kinds of surveys like door to door household survey, market survey, traffic survey, hotel and tourist survey (if the field area selected is a popular tourist spot). These close interactions with the inhabitants during the interviews enable the students to learn how man interacts with his surrounding environment in the local set up. The problems that the inhabitants face in their day to day life are identified and noted during the surveys .

These activities performed in the field are expected

- to develop expertise in selection of study area based on a specific problem, methodology for studying the area and its characters in detail
- to handle different logistics and other emergencies on field
- to develop skills in photography, surveying mapping and video recording

In the post field works at the time of preparing the detailed field report students learn different quantitative and qualitative techniques of analysis of the data collected from the field , and to draw meaningful conclusions out of the analysis done. Sometimes fruitful measures or solutions are also suggested at the end of the field report after a thorough study and data analysis.

The students also learn how to write a report with proper illustrations of diagrams and maps collected from secondary and primary sources and to present the data in an aesthetic way.

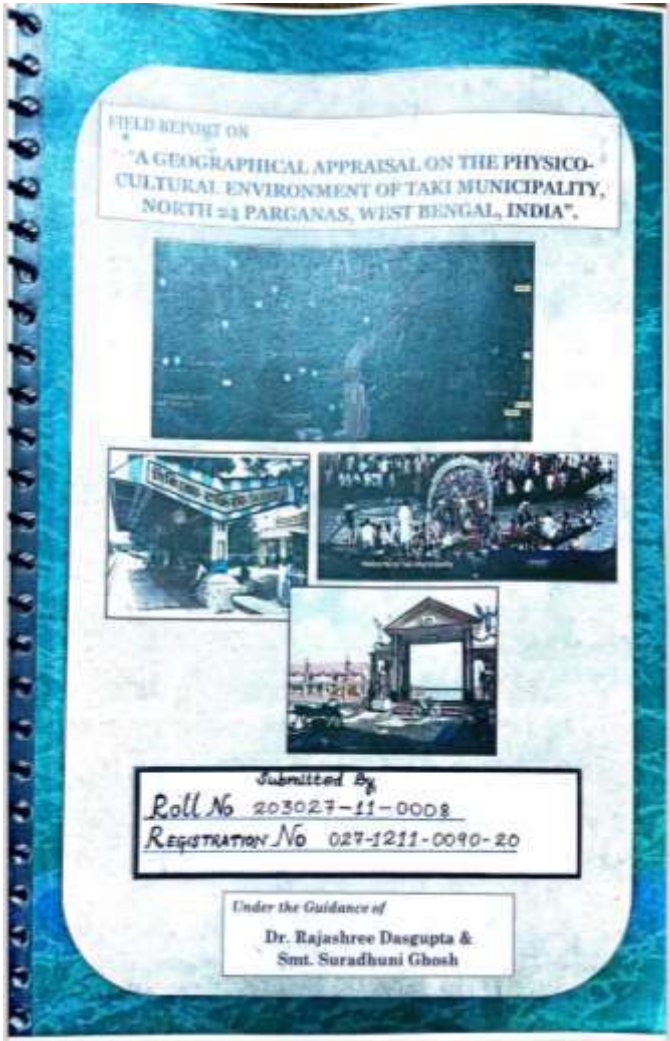

Four Days Educational Field Trip to Bolpur Town, Birbhum District, West Bengal,

As part of the syllabus curriculum in Practical Paper of Semester V- CC11 (CBCS) in Geography at the Undergraduate level under University of Calcutta, an educational field trip was arranged in the session 2023-2024 for Geography Semester V students in an urban setup of Bolpur Town at Birbhum District, West Bengal from 16th of November to 19th of November, 2023. The town was selected for carrying out the man-environment relationship study since the town is facing a major rise in population pressure in the last two decades from the surrounding parts and the urban environment has started facing some major challenges due to huge influx of people. This locale is also a very popular tourist spot in West Bengal where tourists both national and international love to visit throughout the year. Recently *Shantiniketan* spot located at a close vicinity of Bolpur town has been designated as a *World Heritage Site* by UNESCO. The region is considered as one of the major educational hubs in the state where *Viswabharati* University is located. The University was founded by the Nobel Laureate World famous renowned Poet and Philosopher Rabindranath Tagore in 1901.

The total team was of 22 members - 18 students accompanied by the faculty members – Dr. Rajashree Dasgupta, Smt. Suradhuni Ghosh and two non-teaching staff members Mr. Kamallesh Mandal and Arup Ghosh went to Bolpur town to carry out the detailed study on man – environment interactions in an urban setup. The students performed detailed socio-economic household survey, road and traffic survey, market survey, hotel survey and tourist survey in the respective locality within the four days stipulated time. They also performed surveying and levelling in open fields with dumpy level and prismatic compass to know the undulations of the relief character of the locality. Soil samples were also collected identifying different plots having different landuses. A detailed land-use mapping of the entire Bolpur town was also carried out. The students also visited different Government Offices like the Bolpur Municipality, Government Primary Health Centre to collect relevant data for their academic purpose.
