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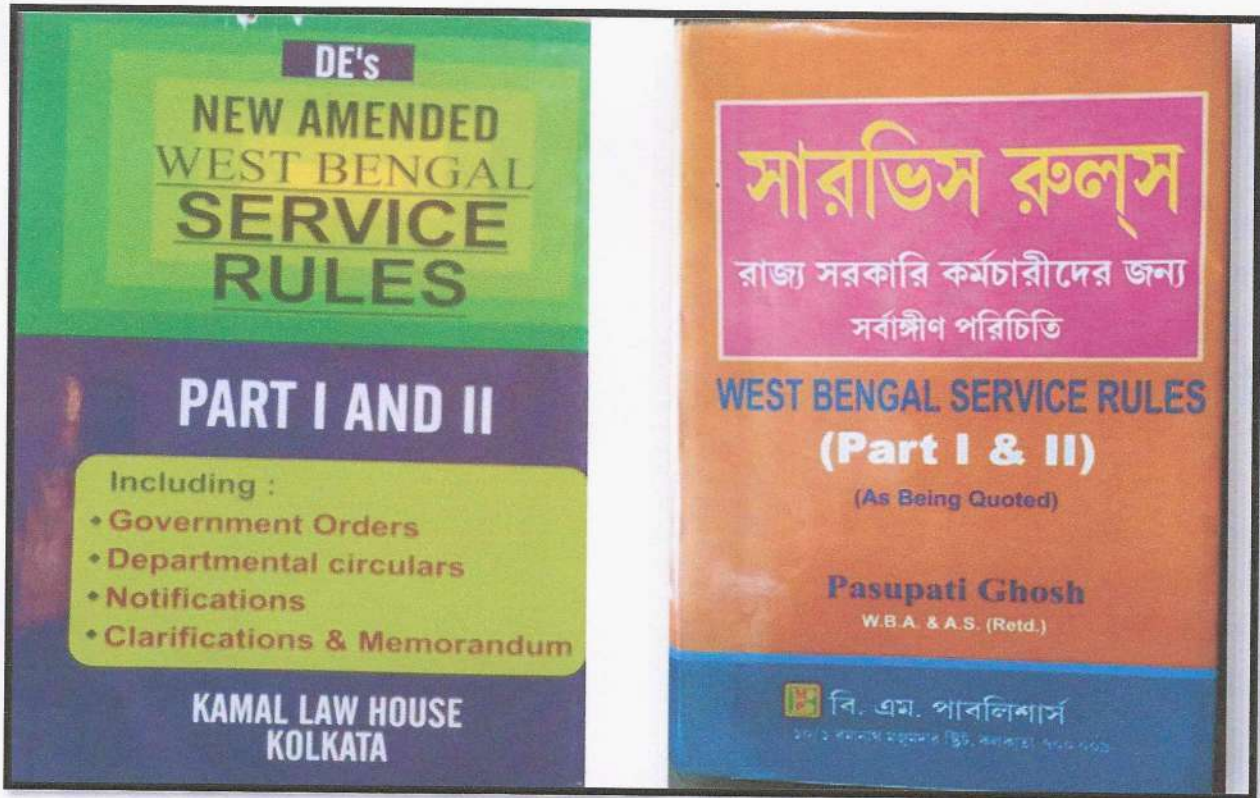

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NOTIFICATION

3857F, dated 15th August 1971.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor is pleased to make the following rules:

CHAPTER I—EXTENT OF APPLICATION

These rules may be called the West Bengal Service Rules, 1971. Except where it is otherwise stated, they shall extend to these States with effect from the 1st day of 1971.

Subject to the provisions of the Constitution of India (1971) where it is otherwise expressed or implied, these rules shall apply to all members of services and holders of posts in the Government of West Bengal appointed to posts in the Government of West Bengal after the 1st day of 1971.

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Chap. III, Rule 13-17

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13. Except as otherwise provided by rule, the medical certificate of fitness referred to in this chapter shall be in the following form:-

"I hereby certify that I have examined A. B., a candidate for employment in the Department, and am of opinion that but any disease, infirmity or other physical constitutional weakness or bodily infirmity except I do not consider this a disqualification for employment in the office of A. B., who is applying for employment in the office of and by agreement about

14. Except as otherwise provided by rule, the certificate referred to in rule 13 shall be obtained:-

- (a) in the case of a candidate for employment in a Group 'A' post from the Medical Committee or its permanent body under the orders of the Administrative Medical Officer of the State; and
- (b) in other cases:-
 - (i) to officers from the District Medical Officers or such other medical officers below the District Medical Officers as Government may by order, as provided; and
 - (ii) to clericals from the Preventive Dispensary as are specially authorized to grant such certificates.

Provided that in the case of a candidate to be appointed to a post in Group 'D' service, the appointing authority may accept a certificate signed by a registered medical practitioner.

15. Unless in any case it be otherwise distinctly provided in the rules, the Government employees in the disposal of the Government shall give time and be employed in any manner required by proper authority, without delay for additional assignment, whether the services required of him are such as would ordinarily be contemplated from general orders from a time to time from the heads of a body corporate owned or controlled by the Government.

16. (1) Two or more Government employees cannot be appointed substantially to the same permanent post at the same time.

- (2) A Government employee cannot be appointed substantially to two or more permanent posts at the same time.
- (3) A Government employee cannot be appointed substantially to a post on which another Government employee holds a lien.

17. Unless in any case it be otherwise provided in these rules, a Government employee on substantive appointment to any permanent post occupies a lien on the post and cannot be held any less permanently assigned on any other post.

Chap. III, Rule 34B

34

Explanation.—In this rule and in rule 34B "Government employee" means a person appointed to a service or post in connection with the affairs of the State and remunerated otherwise than on a daily, weekly or fortnightly basis.

(1) A Government employee who tenders resignation and quits without giving the notice as provided by sub-rule (1) shall, at the discretion of the appointing authority, be liable to forfeiture of his salary for the period by which the notice falls short of the requirements of clause (a) or clause (b), as the case may be, of that sub-rule in addition to such disciplinary action as may be taken against him for contravention of these rules.

4. Note.—Regarding the question of taking back in service a Government employee who resigned and subsequently withdrew such resignation letter the following principles shall be followed:-

- (i) A person continues in service if he withdraws his resignation letter before the date from which the resignation becomes irrevocable and operative after the specified date of resignation. So the question of withdrawal of the resignation letter by the Government employee and taking back such employee in service does not arise. After the resignation has become irrevocable and effective, it cannot be cancelled.
- (ii) Resignation does not diagonally bar a person for fresh appointment and if he is given any appointment after his service in connection with the previous appointment has come to an end on account of resignation, the appointment given subsequently shall always be treated as a fresh appointment without any consideration whatsoever with his previous appointment.
- (iii) Such fresh appointment shall not be possible if the age exceeds the limit prescribed in the rules. The Government or Head of the Department, however, reserves to itself the right to relax the age limit in cases of eminently suitable persons.
- (iv) In case of such fresh appointment the relevant rules relating to recruitment cannot be relaxed in favour of the persons concerned unless the rules confer such power on the appointing authority.

34B. (1) If under the terms of appointment, the Government has a right to terminate the services of a temporary Government employee after serving notice for a specified period, the services of such Government employee may be terminated after serving such notice or after putting him either on suspension for the period of notice required in lieu of such notice.

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Chap. III, Rule 34A

37. If the Government employee does not join duty by the specified date, it would be open to the disciplinary authority to institute disciplinary action against him. If during the currency of the disciplinary proceedings he ceases to be a Government employee, he shall be deemed to have resigned and disciplinary action shall be taken against him as if he had resigned. If, however, he requests for duty before or after institution of disciplinary proceedings, he may be taken back for duty on such terms as may be determined by the disciplinary authority. The disciplinary action may be continued and the period of suspension shall be treated as a period of suspension under the provisions of the rules. The question whether the back should be considered or not and in what manner shall be considered only after termination of the disciplinary proceedings and that too after the Government employee requests to be taken back.

38. (1) If a Government employee absents himself abruptly or applies for leave which is refused in the absence of public service and will happen to absent himself from duty he shall be held of the consequence, viz., that the entire period of absence shall be treated as unauthorised absence including loss of pay for the absence resulting in breach of duty. If, however, he requests for duty before or after institution of disciplinary proceedings, he may be taken back for duty on such terms as may be determined by the disciplinary authority. The disciplinary action may be continued and the period of suspension shall be treated as a period of suspension under the provisions of the rules. The question whether the back should be considered or not and in what manner shall be considered only after termination of the disciplinary proceedings and that too after the Government employee requests to be taken back.

39. A Government employee who remains absent unauthorisedly for a period of three months shall be deemed to have resigned and disciplinary action shall be taken against him as if he had resigned. If, however, he requests for duty before or after institution of disciplinary proceedings, he may be taken back for duty on such terms as may be determined by the disciplinary authority. The disciplinary action may be continued and the period of suspension shall be treated as a period of suspension under the provisions of the rules. The question whether the back should be considered or not and in what manner shall be considered only after termination of the disciplinary proceedings and that too after the Government employee requests to be taken back.

34A. (1) No Government employee shall, unless the Government otherwise directs, be permitted to resign if he fails to serve his appointing authority due notice as hereunder:-

- (a) in the case of a Government employee holding an lien on a permanent post or a permanent post under the Government, - one month; or
- (b) in the case of a Government employee holding lien or a permanent post on a government post under the Government, three months.

42

42. The initial substantive pay of the Government employee who is appointed substantively to a post in a time-scale of pay is regulated as follows:-

- (1) If he holds a lien on a permanent post, other than a casual post, or would hold a lien on such a post had his lien not been surrendered:-
 - (a) when appointment to the new post involves the assumption of duties or responsibilities of greater importance (as interpreted for the purposes of rule 40) than those attaching to such permanent post, he will draw an initial pay the stage of the time-scale next above his substantive pay in respect of the old post;
 - (b) when appointment to the new post does not involve such assumption, he will draw as initial pay the stage of the time-scale which is equal to his substantive pay in respect of the old post, or, if there is no such stage, the stage next below that pay; after personal pay equal to the difference; and in either case will continue to draw that pay until such time as he would have received an increment in the time-scale of the old post or for the period after which an increment is earned in the time-scale of the new post, whichever is earlier; afterwards he will draw pay in the stage of the new time-scale next above that which he draws initially, and thereafter he will lose any personal pay granted under this rule and all connection with the old time-scale. But if the minimum pay of the new post is higher than his substantive pay in respect of the old post, he will draw that minimum as initial pay.
 - (c) when appointment to the new post is made on his own request under sub-rule (1) of rule 24 and the minimum pay in the time-scale of that post is less than the substantive pay in respect of the old post, he will draw that minimum as initial pay.
 - (2) If the conditions prescribed in clause (1) are not fulfilled, he will draw as initial pay the minimum of the time-scale.
- Provided that in cases covered by clause (1) and in cases other than cases of re-employment after resignation or removal or dismissal from the permanent service, covered by clause (2), that if he either:-
- (a) has held an any previous occasion or occasions either substantively or in an officiating or temporary capacity;-
 - (b) the same post; or

(i) a permanent or a temporary post on the same time-scale, or

(ii) a permanent post, other than a tenure post, on an identical time-scale as a temporary post on an identical time-scale; or

(b) is appointed, substantively to a tenure post on a time-scale identical with that of another tenure post which he has previously held substantively or in which he has previously officiated; or

then the initial pay shall not be less than the pay which he would have drawn on the time-scale to which he is appointed, if he had drawn on the last preceding time-scale, and he shall count the period during which he drew that pay on such last and any previous occasion for increments in the stage of the time-scale equivalent to that pay.

Notes 1 and 2.—Omitted.

Note 3.—A time-scale may be of recent introduction, whereas the code or class to which it is attached may have been in existence on a graded scale before the time-scale came into force or it may be that one time-scale has taken the place of another. If a Government employee has held substantively, or officiated in, a post in the code or class prior to the introduction of a new time-scale and has drawn during the period salary or pay equal to a stage, or intermediate between two stages, in the new time-scale, then the initial pay in the new time-scale may be fixed at the salary or pay last drawn and the period during which it was drawn may be counted for increment in the same stage, or if the salary or pay was intermediate between two stages in the lower stage of that time-scale.

Note 4.—The re-employment of a Government employee after resignation or after discharge (on reduction of establishment or after removal or dismissal, as equivalent to a first appointment to Government service for the purpose of this rule. He will therefore draw the minimum of the time-scale unless a higher rate of pay is specially sanctioned under rule 42.

Note 5.—Reversion to the ordinary code of service from a tenure post included in that code or from a tenure or special post not included in it does not constitute "substantive appointment to a post" for the purpose of this rule.

Note 6.—The expression "if he holds a lien on a permanent post" occurring in clause (i) of rule 42 should be held to include the lien on a permanent post to which a Government employee is appointed in a provisional substantive capacity under sub-rule (a), of rule 20, and the expression "substantive pay in respect of the old post" occurring in that rule should be held to include his substantive pay in respect of that provisional substantive appointment. Clause (i) of rule 42 should, therefore, be held to permit the substantive pay in respect of a provisional substantive

appointment being taken into account in determining his initial pay in another post to which he is appointed. When the initial pay of Government employee in a post is thus fixed, it will not be affected even if during the tenure of his appointment to that post he reverts from his provisional appointment.

**Note 7.—Where a Government employee, except on tenure appointment, is in receipt of a special pay attached to the scale of pay of a post, his pay on appointment to a higher post shall be fixed under the normal rules after treating the special pay as a part of the basic pay drawn in the lower post.

Provided that—

(a) special pay, not so attached to the scale of pay of a post but sanctioned otherwise under rule 5(33) or special pay drawn in a tenure appointment or special pay (deputation allowance drawn while on deputation that not be taken into consideration for this purpose; and

(b) in cases where the appointment in the lower post carrying the special pay is on officiating basis, the appropriate authority shall certify that but for appointment to the higher post the Government employee concerned would have continued to draw the special pay attached to the lower post.

**42A. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any rule elsewhere, where a Government employee holding a post in a substantive, temporary or officiating capacity is promoted or appointed in a substantive, temporary or officiating capacity to another post carrying duties and responsibilities of greater importance than those attached to the post held by him, the initial pay of such Government employee in the scale of pay of the higher post shall be fixed at the stage next above the pay last drawn by him, or if the pay last drawn by him is not a pay last drawn by him, the initial pay of such Government employee in the scale of pay of the higher post shall be fixed at the stage next above the pay last drawn by him, or if the pay last drawn by him is not a pay last drawn by him, the initial pay of such Government employee in the scale of pay of the higher post shall be fixed at the stage next above the pay last drawn by him.

Provided that the provisions of this sub-rule shall not apply where a Government employee holding a Group A post in a substantive, temporary or officiating capacity is promoted or appointed in a substantive, temporary or officiating capacity to a higher post which is also a Group A post.

Provided further that the provisions of sub-rule (2) of rule 58 shall not be applicable in any case where the initial pay is fixed under this sub-rule.

Provided also that where a Government employee was, immediately before his promotion or appointment to a higher post, drawing pay at the maximum of the scale of pay of the lower post, the initial pay of such Government employee in the scale of pay of the higher post shall be fixed at the stage next above the pay last drawn by him, or if the pay last drawn by him is not a pay last drawn by him, the initial pay of such Government employee in the scale of pay of the higher post shall be fixed at the stage next above the pay last drawn by him.

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[Chap. V, Rule 42A

Provided also that if a Government employee—

(a) has previously held substantively or officiated in—

(i) the same post, or

(ii) a permanent or temporary post on the same scale of pay, or

(iii) a permanent post other than a tenure post or a temporary post (including a post in a body, institution, or office, which is wholly or substantially owned or controlled by the Government) on an identical scale of pay; or

(b) is appointed substantively to a tenure post on a scale of pay, identical with that of another tenure post which he has previously held substantively or in which he has previously officiated, then, proviso to rule 42 shall apply in the matter of the initial fixation of pay and counting of previous service for increments.

Note 1.—The existing rule regarding fixation of pay of temporary Government employees having no lien on any permanent post on their appointment to posts carrying higher time-scale of pay, provides nothing more than the minimum of the time-scale in the higher post. As a result, the last pay drawn in the lower post being greater than the minimum of the higher scale in most cases is not protected and the officer concerned is put to hardship. The Government has been pleased to decide that, in all such cases, a temporary Government employee having no lien on any post when appointed to hold a post carrying higher time-scale of pay, shall be eligible to draw as initial pay the stage of the time-scale in the higher post which is equal to his pay in the lower post, or if there is no such stage, the stage next below that pay plus personal pay equal to the difference, to be absorbed in future increments in the higher scale, provided that he has already rendered at least three years' continuous and satisfactory service in the lower post.

Note 2.—The benefit of fixation of pay referred to in note 1 shall not, however, be available in the following cases—

(1) when a temporary Government employee appointed to a higher post, on the recommendation of the Public Service Commission, West Bengal, and in whose case the Commission has, at the request of the Government, made specific recommendation regarding the pay to be allowed to the officer;

(2) when under any specific rule a temporary Government employee on appointment to a higher post is allowed a higher initial pay.

(3) Notwithstanding anything contained elsewhere in these rules, the pay of the Government employee shall, in respect of all promotional/appointments from one Group A post to another Group A post carrying higher responsibilities, be fixed at the stage next above the pay drawn in the scale of pay of the lower post, irrespective of whether the lower post is held on substantive, or officiating or temporary basis.

The TC read out the list of members of the newly formed Monthly Study Committee comprising of college staff (teachers & support staff) & some external members. The Principal elaborated on the various aspects of the letter which is being sent in collaboration with another college & some other organisations & final decision will be held on.

Appt. Gupta suggested for a person that she will act as the Secretary of the committee. She will act as a whole - Gupta then spoke up and expressed her desire to be elected from the committee itself.

The Principal conveyed her displeasure about the late arrival of some teachers. She requested all teachers to come to college punctually. Moreover, she requested all teachers to follow their routine.

The Principal also brought up the issue of some 10th/11th or other examinees (of 20 or other years) showing their marks uploaded with help of the office staff, which was mentioned in the meeting with the meeting head (of 10th/11th) on 1.4.23. Some staff have apparently objected to this, although they have no objection to 10th/11th marks. The T.C. and 10th/11th staff both elaborated on this issue, as both were present at the said meeting. As per suggested writing a portion of the teachers' claims to the staff.

Supriya Baidya pointed out that in Commerce (not 10th/11th probably) a specific mark is now also considered for the College.

Madal Bhatia pointed out that as the teachers concerned do not even know how much their claim is and as there must have been clear cut discussion of labour between teaching & non-teaching staff. This was supported by many teachers.

Supriya Baidya pointed out that there is a growing gap difference between the quantity of marks uploaded by the 10th and the examinees. Her opinion is that it is advisable for the T.C. to find out how the marks were made per subject, as that perhaps an amicable understanding may be arrived at. The Principal nodded up by saying that we should find out about the students to examine/10th for sample and then decide on the amount/percentage for the staff.

The Principal brought up the issue of the Committee members to submit their respective expenses in ledger form for the whole year. He then elaborated and explained that this was for sake of account-keeping and reporting of accounts.

The maximum period of detention remains 15 days.

Principal informed the TC that the 10th/11th students have got approval and they must not have been. A list of links (also) should be submitted & each kept & appropriate report.

Cultural events: The last Annual Day celebration faced some hitches due to the failure of the sound/electricity men to finish their work. The Principal from Chhatrapati & Supriya Baidya explained the situation which arose this year. Principal suggested the formation of an elected cultural committee (of students) who could go out for sponsorships and be involved in all activities. The necessity of a elected body notwithstanding, the process of election was opposed by some members. This has been resolved as a suggestion to be taken up in details in future.

Principal: Urdu, Arabic, Persian & Hindi depts have arranged an Inter fair on 11.04.23. List of students from each dept to be submitted to these depts.

Approval of meeting of 1.4.23 with S. Jay Chatterjee. The Principal let me the TC know that it was decided that Rajesh Ghosh would do most of the outside work (P.A., Exam. Board, etc. etc.), but in case of emergency, Thiruv. Bhatia would do that work.

Metel: Supriya Baidya explained that the Govt. school (Bhatia) & Principal has categorically decided that they do not have further permission (Sec. 115-20) for accommodating our students. This was emergency.

Supriya Baidya brought up the important point that the 10th group administration of the college has left the college and therefore must be immediately replaced.



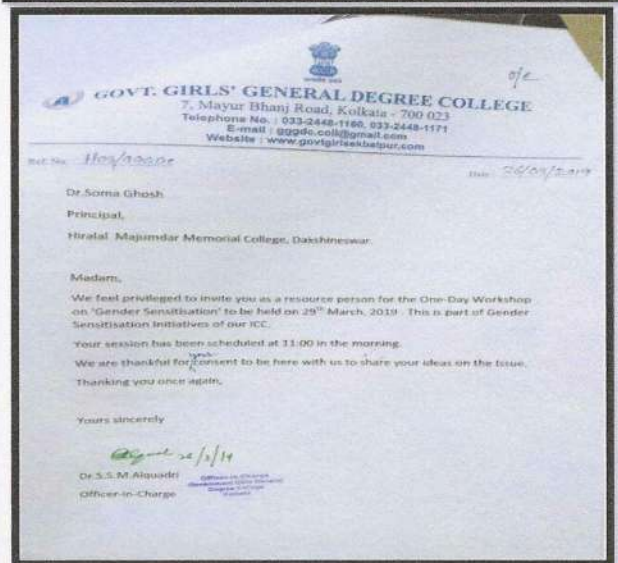
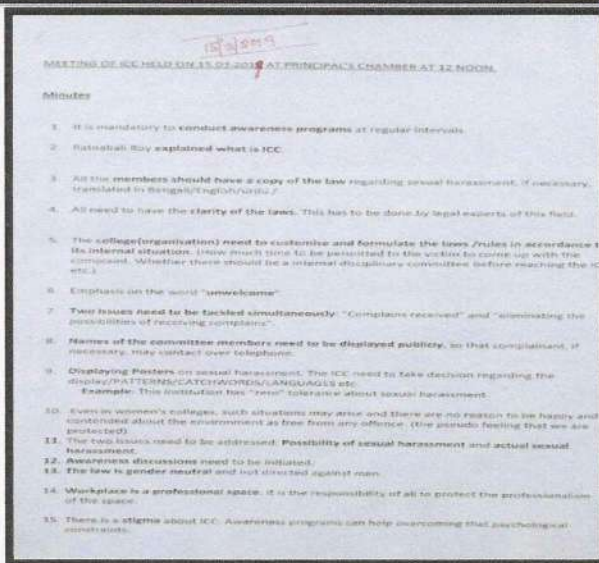
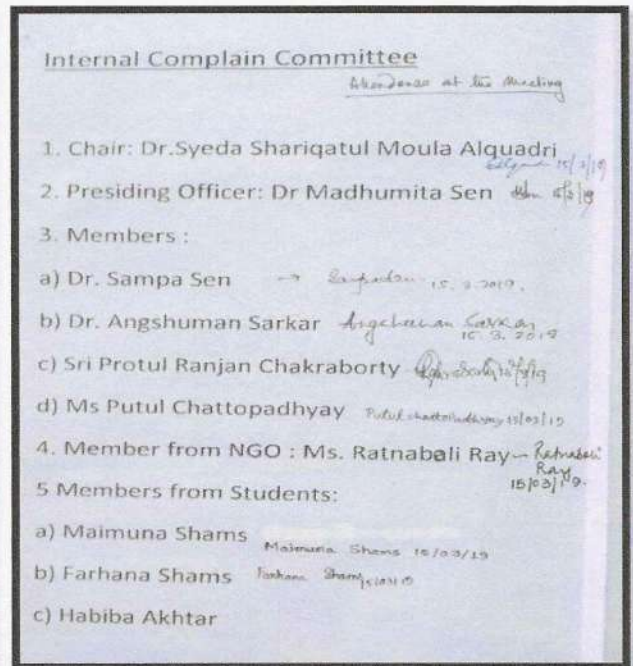
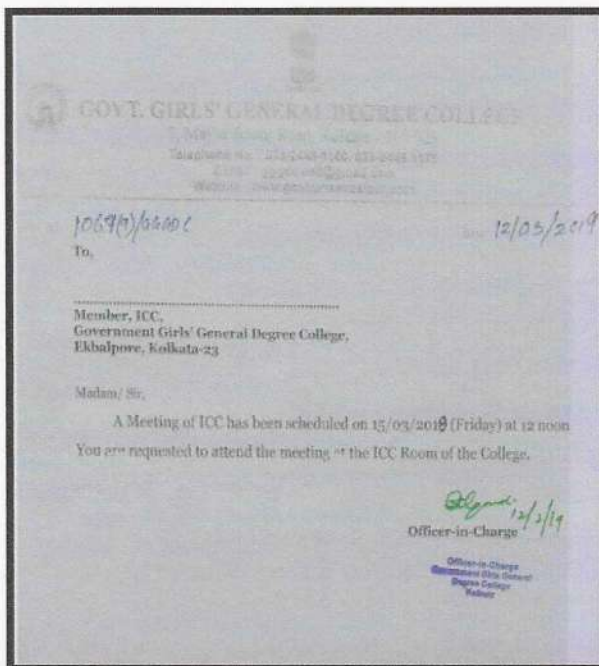

Subj: Online admissions for the Academic Session 2023-2024 to all UG Courses

The results of the West Bengal Higher Secondary Examination 2023 and equivalent examinations have been announced in the month of May 2023. This Department has received queries from different State-aided Universities & Colleges regarding the admission modalities to be followed by them for the ensuing academic session 2023-2024.

The Expert Committee, constituted regarding implementation of the National Curriculum and Credit Framework (NCCF), vide UGC D.O. No. 1-1/2021(QIP)(CBSCS) dated 31.01.2023, has recommended the implementation of NCCF for 4-years UG programmes from the academic year 2023-2024 in all Government/ aided Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) in the State through optimum utilization of existing resources or self-mobilization of additional resources, pending receipt of additional financial assistance. The competent authority in the State Government has accepted the recommendations of the Expert Committee and decided to introduce 4 year UG level programmes in all HEIs, as stated above, from academic session 2023-2024.

Besides, the Centralized Admission Portal, which has been developed based on existing 3-years degree UG programmes, shall have to undergo suitable modifications regarding the institution-level admission rules/subject combination/ fee structures etc. across the State. In view of the time constraints required for such modifications in the Portal and the preparedness of the Universities to implement NCCF as reported by the Expert Committee, it is hereby informed to all concerned that the admissions to all Under Graduate programmes in the State-funded Higher Education Institutions in West Bengal for the ensuing academic session 2023-2024 shall be made online in Standalone mode, like previous years, as per the schedule & modalities detailed below:

Schedule:

For Under Graduate Programmes (1st semester admission)

- a) Date of opening of Standalone Online Portal for Application for UG programmes – 01st July 2023
- b) Submission of Applications in the Standalone Online Portal for UG programmes by – 15th July 2023
- c) Publication of Merit Lists in UG programmes by – 20th July 2023
- d) Completion of Admission in the UG programmes by – 31st July 2023
- e) Start of 1st Semester classes of UG programmes on – 1st August 2023



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However, beyond the above schedule the willing HEIs may reopen their Standalone Admission Portal for another 02 (two) phases, if required, subject to availability of vacancies at the Institution level. But it is advised that the entire process of admission at UG level be completed positively by 31st August 2023.

Modalities:

- 1) On-line admission process should be done strictly based on merit. Prospective students should not be called for counseling or verification of documents during the process of admission. No physical presence will be required at the HEIs.
- 2) No Charges shall be taken from the students for (i) scanning/ uploading of documents for online admission and (ii) providing/ making available the application form/ prospectus of admission in all UG level programmes like last year.
- 3) Eligible applicants should be informed directly by the HEI authorities through letter or e-mail or telecommunication.
- 4) Payment of fees should be done only through e-payment or designated banks and not physically at the colleges.
- 5) List of eligible applicants should be handed over to the designated bank branches for verification during payment through banks. Banks will receive admission fees based on merit list.
- 6) All testimonials are required to be uploaded online during application. Verification of documents, if required, should be done only when the students report for the classes in due course. Admission will be cancelled if the documents are found not in conformity with the declaration in the forms submitted on-line.
- 7) All Stakeholders shall adhere to the COVID-19 norms/ protocol, issued by the Government from time to time.

Vice-Chancellors/ Registrars of all State-aided Universities are requested to take necessary steps in this regard, including issuance of suitable instructions to all the affiliated institutions. However, the Netaji Subhas Open University shall follow the time schedule as per guidelines of Open Distance Learning as done last year.

This advisory does not apply to admission to teacher training courses such as B.Ed., B.P.Ed., M.Ed., or M.P.Ed. or PG and higher-level courses etc., for which a separate Notification will be issued.
